

A47 North Tuddenham to Easton

Full weekend closure

31 July to 3 August 2026

The A47 will be fully closed in both directions between Wood Lane Junction and Longwater Interchange from between 8pm on 31 July until 6am on 3 August. All side road access onto the A47 along this stretch will also be closed.

Residents living directly on the A47 will be escorted through the closure by traffic marshals when needed. Emergency services will still have access. The B1535 Wood Lane to the A1067 will remain fully open.

These closures will allow us to safely remove Easton Roundabout as part of the A47 upgrade to dual carriageway.

Diversion Route

Westbound diversion: A47 → A11 → A134 → A1065 → rejoin A47 at Swaffham

Eastbound diversion: A47 → A1065 → A134 → A11 → rejoin A47 toward Norwich

There will be a new road layout when the road reopens at 6am on 3 August. The Easton Roundabout will have been fully removed, with east to west traffic routed onto the new dual carriageway. There will be:

- No access onto Dereham Road and Church Lane in Easton from the A47
- A 3.25m width restriction affecting oversized loads.
